

Cookie statement January 2019

What is a cookie? Cookies are used on our website. Cookies are simple, small text files that are placed on your computer (or your IP address) via this website and record information about your visit to the website. Your browser stores the cookie on your computer's hard drive. The information stored therein can be sent back to our servers the next time you visit our website. Cookies cannot damage the files on your computer.

Analytical cookies Analytical cookies are used to see which parts of the website you have viewed with this visit. This way we can adapt our service (s) as much as possible to the surfing behavior of our visitors. These cookies are automatically deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

Google Analytics This website uses the Analytics service of the American company Google. Through our website, a cookie is placed by Google. We use this service from Google to keep track of and receive reports on how visitors use the website. Google may provide this information to third parties if Google is legally obliged to do so, or insofar as third parties process the information on Google's behalf. We have no influence on this. We have not allowed Google to use the analytics information obtained for other Google services.

The information Google collects is anonymised as much as possible. Your IP address will not be given. The information is transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will adhere to the Privacy Shield principles and is affiliated to the Privacy Shield program of the U.S. Department of Commerce. This ensures an appropriate level of protection for the processing of any personal data.

Right of access and correction or deletion of your data You have the right to request access to and correction or deletion of your data. Our contact details can be found on our contact page. To prevent misuse, we may ask you to identify yourself. If you wish to view personal data linked to a cookie, we ask you to enclose a copy of the cookie in question. You can find this in the settings of your browser.
